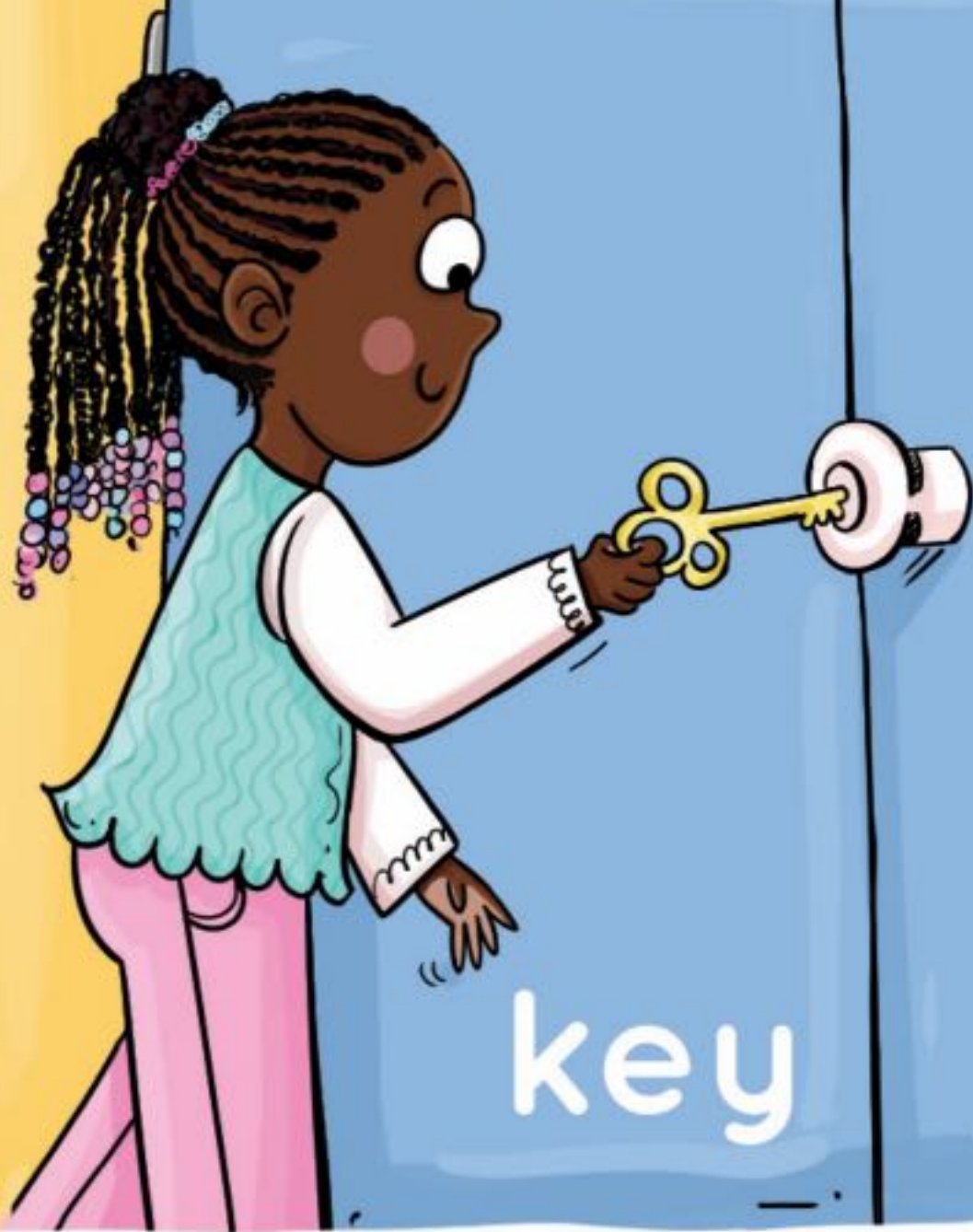

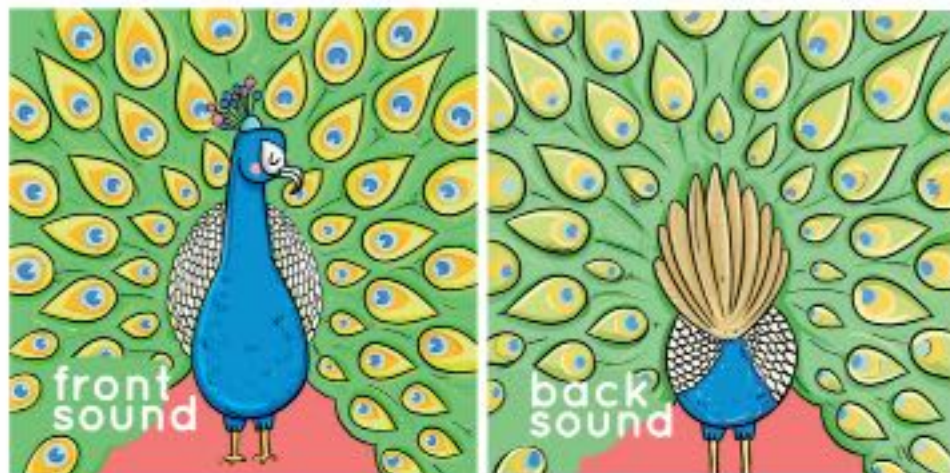
FRONTING & BACKING CUE

Cue #1 Front Sounds vs. Back Sounds

for velar and palatal fronting and backing



Suggested teaching: Just like people and animals have a front and back, so do some sounds.

Our front sounds are 't', 'd' and 's'.

Our back sounds are 'k', 'g' and 'sh'.

Cue #3 Tapping Sounds vs. Coughing Sounds

for velar fronting and backing



Suggested teaching: Some sounds are made with a 'tapping' tongue, while other sounds are made like a coughing sound at the back of our throat.

Our tapping sounds are 't' and 'd'.

Our coughing sounds are 'k' and 'g'.
