




FAMILIARIZATION "A cow likes to moo"


moo - moon - moose



tail sound



Cue #1 Tail Sound for final consonant deletion



(The cards are designed to join together to make a continuous picture. You might remove a card if the child omits the sound.)

Suggested teaching: Just like animals have tails, so do some words. An animal would look different without its tail, just like words might sound different if we forget to use our tail sound. Tail Sounds are the last consonant sound at the end of a word, like 'k', 'p', 't', and 's'.





Cue #3 Disappearing Sound

for final consonant deletion



Suggested teaching: Just like a magician can make things vanish and disappear, sometimes our last sound in a word can accidentally disappear too!

The Disappearing Sounds are the last consonant sound at the end of a word, like 'k', 'p', 't', and 's'.
