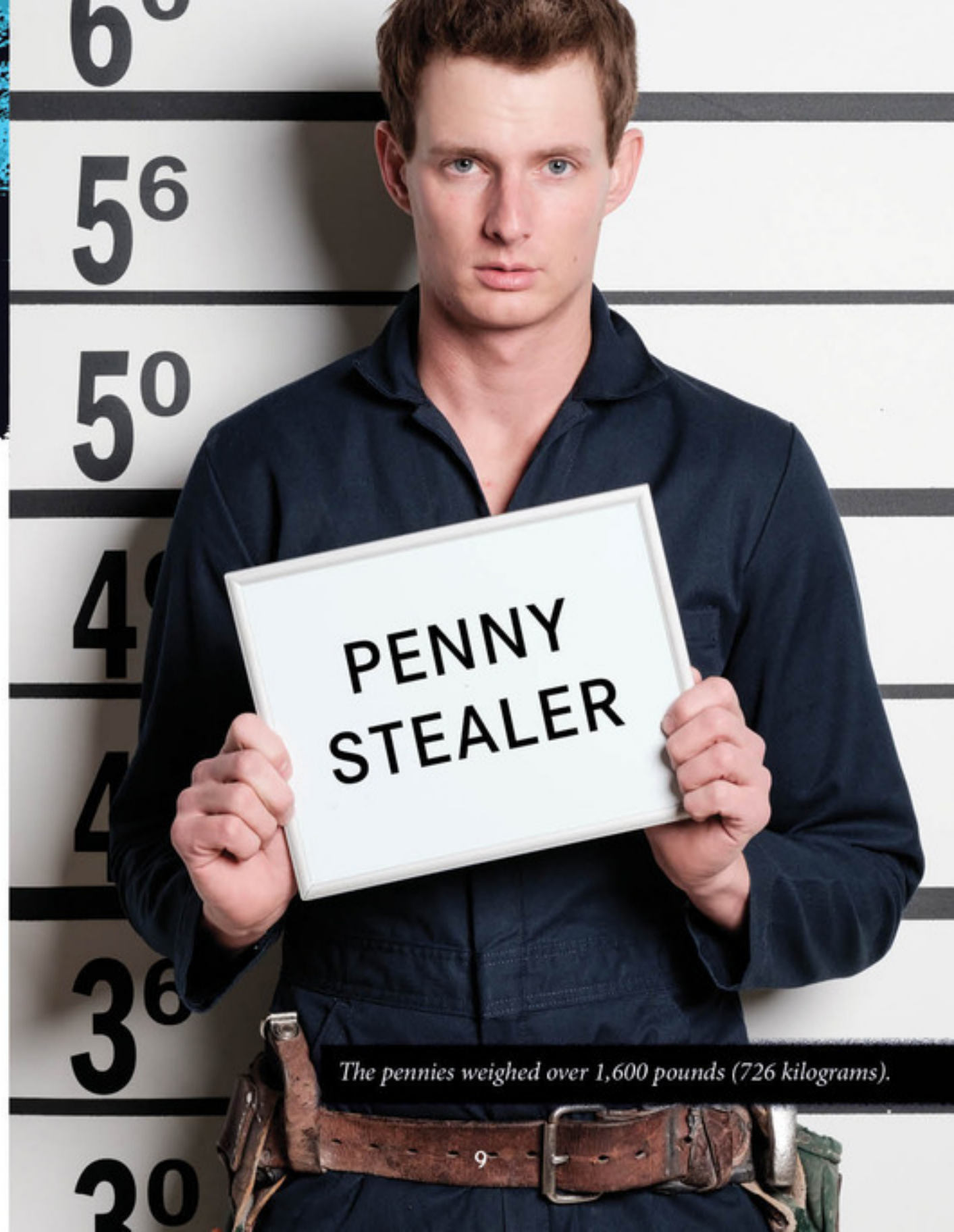


Penny Stealer
