



## How to enjoy this book

Each of the seven 'Let's Learners Love Literacy' stages is carefully sequenced to give children confidence and success. Encourage children to use their speed words knowledge to decode or sound out\* any unfamiliar words.

**Teaching Note:** The diagram below representing WHO both coded and uncoded.

### Secret words



**Vocabulary check:** Discuss these words either before or after reading the book.  
love = something  
more = much  
long = longer

What word means quick? (Can you think of other words that mean quick?)  
(fast, quickly, rapidly)

**Questions to help answer:** These questions can be used after reading to discuss the book. Children just look back through the book to answer.

- What animal is this book about? Where does it live?
- Who is telling you the facts first?
- Are sloths fast or slow? (Sloths are slow on land but fast in water)
- Can you tell from a sloth's tailing the kind of tree it has?
- Our baby is such a thrill! Why an why not?
