WE RECOMMEND USING THE WORKSHEETS IN THE FOLLOWING SEQUENCE:

A, B, read the *Reader*, **C, D**, read the *Reader* again, **F, G, H, I**. Use **E** sheets at any time.

A-SHEETS - New Sounds

- 31A: **a-e** as in *cake*, **ou** as in *out*
- 32A: **oa** as in *boat*, **u** as in *bush*
- 33A: **i-e** as in *bike*
- 34A: **o-e** as in *note*
- 35A: **ea** as in *head*
- 36A: **or** as in *sort*
- 37A: **ew** as in *crew*
- 38A: **ie** as in *pie*
- 39A: **oi** as in *coin*
- 40A: **ea** (*heat*), **ur** (*burn*), **air** (*hair*)

B-SHEETS - Special Words

The **B** sheets provide exercises to introduce and practise the *special words* for the corresponding *Reader*.

E-SHEETS - Word Searches

The word searches use vocabulary from the corresponding *Reader*, particularly the special words (sight words). These sheets may be used for students who finish ahead of others.

F-SHEETS - Comprehension

The **F** sheets provide comprehension questions based on the corresponding *Reader*. These require the student to write the answers in their exercise book.

G-SHEETS - Practical English

The **G** sheets include:

- subjects for discussion to enhance oral and conceptual development,
- writing activities using common English turns of phrase,
- and practical writing tasks such as instructions, lists or letters.

H-SHEETS - Written Expression

The **H** sheets include:

- subjects for story composition,
- working with the *Reader*, such as re-writing the ending or changing the perspective of the story,
- persuasive writing, where students give their reasons to form a convincing argument.

I-SHEETS - Multiple Choice and Sequencing Comprehension

The **I** sheets include:

- numbering sentences based on the order they occurred in the corresponding *Reader*,
- reading short texts and answering multiple choice comprehension questions.
