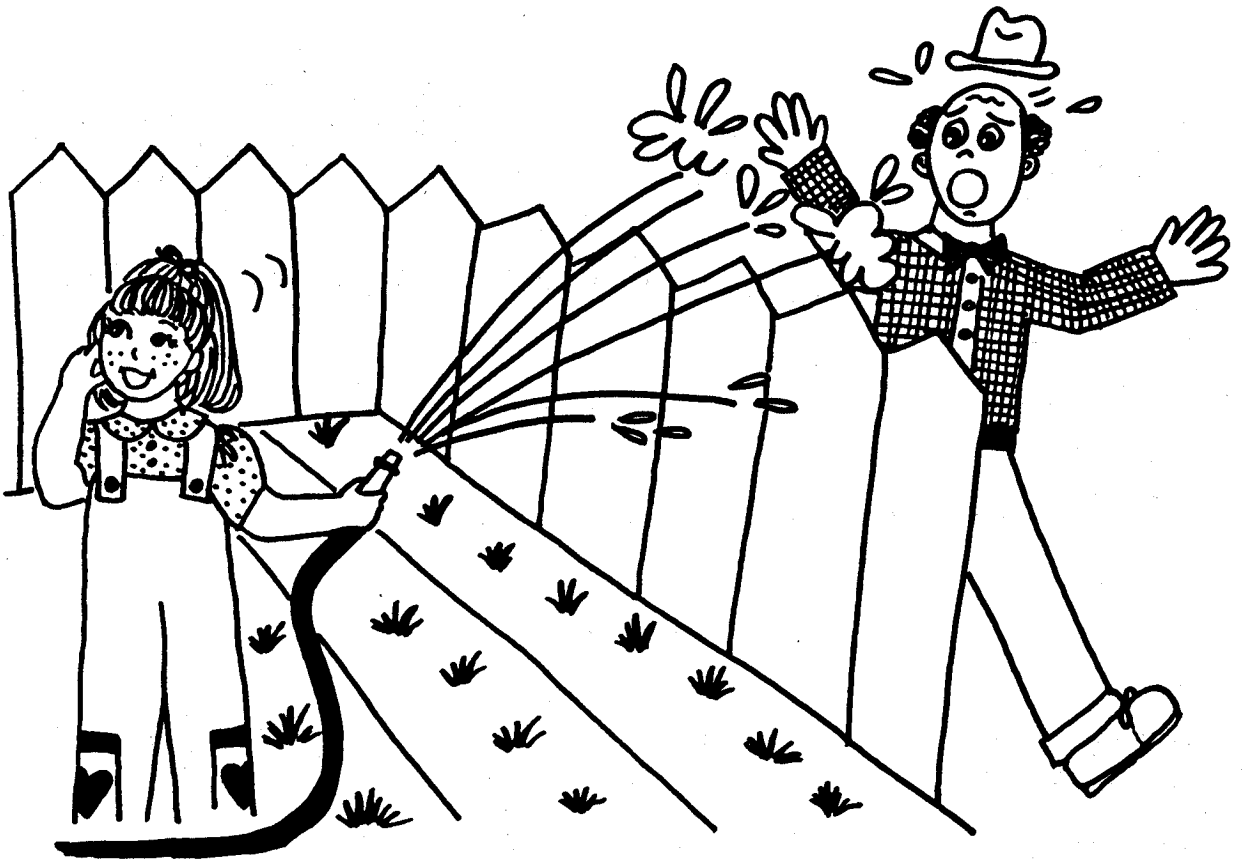
1. What should Margo say to Mr. Jones?
