

How To Play

1. Select a Wordy Wheel and place it on the game base.
2. Place the electronic spinner in the center of the base. Be sure to align the spinner with the wheel to ensure that each light on the spinner corresponds with a single photo on the wheel.
3. Choose one player to go first and press the spinner button.
4. The student practices saying the word, phrase, or sentence on which the spinner lands and earns the number of chips indicated on the spinner. For the phrase level, have students read or repeat the words in red on the sentence side of the card.
5. Play continues to the right.
6. The player to collect the most chips wins!

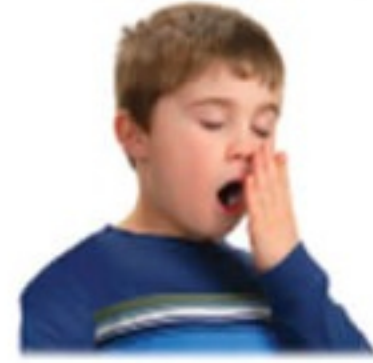
