## Content Card

The **Webber Sequencing Fun Deck®** with **Super Duper® Secret Decoder** targets sequencing skills through reading comprehension, reasoning, and inferencing. Using three decks of cards, students practice the concept of sequencing events.

Each deck gives the student practice in determining an event missing from a sequence of three. For example, in the Deck One, the first event is missing. After reading the second and third events, students must infer from three answers, which event happened first. The second deck is missing the second event, and the third deck is missing what happened last.

Students can use the **Super Duper® Secret Decoder** to check their answers, which are hidden by invisible ink!

## Game Ideas

### Read Aloud:

Read aloud each card to the players. The first player to answer the question on the card correctly keeps the card. The player with the most cards wins!

### You're Out of Order!:

Using any deck, choose a card and read the events out of order. Player One listens to the events and repeats them in the correct order. If the player is right, he/she keeps the card. If the player is wrong, the rest of the players say, "You're out of order!" Play continues in turn. Player with the most cards wins!

### Add an Event:

Player One comes up with the title for a sequence of events and then says what the first event is. (Title: "Making a sandwich." First event: "I get out the bread.") Player Two says the next part of the sequence. (Second event: "I get out the peanut butter and jelly). Play continues in turn until the scenario is complete (Complete event: "Then I eat the sandwich!")

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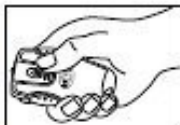

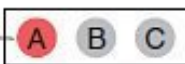
First, remove the isolator strip between the batteries. Then gently squeeze the button just above the Super Duper® logo with your thumb and turn on the light.
