Directions: Regular Play

1. Place nine cards face down on the table in front of the student(s). (Make sure there is one card representing each of the nine different shapes: square, heart, diamond, circle, triangle, rectangle, octagon, star, and oval.)



- 2. Let a student roll the double dice.
- The student determines the shape on the outer die and turns over the corresponding card.
- The student determines the number on the inner die and reads (or listens as you read) the corresponding sentence.
- 5. The student forms a question using the bolded word (cards 1-27) or fills in the blank with the appropriate question word (cards 28-54).
- 6. The card is returned face down to its original place on the table.
- 7. The next student rolls the double dice.
- 8. This continues until time runs out.
