

Syllable Practice

Syllable Practice is ideal for targeting unintelligible speech due to phonological processes, apraxia, and articulation delays. It is also appropriate for children with general delays in phonological awareness.

Syllable Practice features 72 multisyllabic words with pictures on double-sided cards; 60 syllable dot cards featuring two, three, or four syllables (20 words each) and 6 additional cards for generalization practice. Side A of the syllable dot cards features a picture of the target word, the printed syllabicated word, and “syllable dots.” Side B features the same picture, has no dots, and the printed word is not separated into syllables. Six cards featuring 12 additional words are included for more practice!
