INDUS FACT

The Indus Valley Civilization was named after its location. Mohenjo Daro and other cities were located on or near the Indus River. Many were built along the southern part of the river, in a valley. Harappa was built on the south bank of the Ravi River.

Some researchers think the two cities may have been part of two large nations. Others think the rulers **alternated** (ALL•ter•naye•ed) capitals of just one nation. To alternate means to switch back and forth.
