Sounds: **th** -zz, -ll, -ff, -ss; -ck, all consonants, all short vowels

Sight words: is, the, no, a, and, have, love, so, to, of, do, I, he, be, for, me, was, we, she, are, you, want(s), said, go, sees, began, give(s), your, good, put(s), all, by, her, does, they, **there**

Contractions: **can't** it's, let's

Summary: To hide from an angry moth, Zac jumps into a birdbath. Little does he know that the bath is full of a gooey muck. Now Zac is stuck! Who will help him out of the bath?

Special vocabulary: moth, thick

Reading comprehension questions:

1. What was Zac doing when the moth bit him?
2. Why did the moth fly away?
3. Using the words "first," "second," and "third," explain how Zac got out of the bath.
