The Wish

Level 2, Unit 5, Book 13

Sounds: **sh** wh, ch, th; -zz, -ll, -ff, -ss; -ck; all consonants; all short vowels

Sight words: is, the, no, a, and, have, so, to, my, of, do, I, he, be, for, me, was, we, are, you, want, said, see, began, give(s), your, good, put, all, by, does, they, there, how, from, hi, saw, which, too, what **look, or, ask(s)**

Contractions: can't, it's, let's

Summary: Liz, Ann, and Max find a shell with a genie (a “man”) inside. He grants them a wish with specific restrictions. Discover how the kids work together to obtain the genie’s offer.

Special vocabulary: hush, posh

Reading comprehension questions:

1. The man has rules about the kids’ wish. What are the rules?
2. Do you think the kids made a good choice? Explain why or why not.
3. If you found a man in a shell, what would you wish for?
