Extreme MotoGP: Know the Lingo

Apex: the tightest point on a corner

Braking marker: a point a rider uses to judge braking

Endo: stopping a bike to lift the rear wheel off the

ground

Hairpin: a very tight corner that has to be taken slowly

High side: a crash in which the rear wheel of the bike

slides out from under the rider

Hole-shot: leading the race at the first corner

Low side: a crash in which the rear wheel or both wheels lose control, causing the bike to slip out from

underneath the rider

Pit-box: a temporary garage

Slicks: tires with no tread

Tire wall: stacked tires used as a crash barrier to reduce

damage and injury on impact

Topping the timesheet: recording the fastest time

Wheelie: lifting the front wheel of a bike
