

GATHER OR HUNT?



Sometimes, early humans had to walk a long time to find food.

Early humans lived in small groups. They collected food for each other. They lived off the land. If there was plenty of food, they stayed. They protected the land. If food ran out, they migrated to different lands.

They gathered plants. They ate grasses. They ate fruits. They ate seeds. They ate nuts.

They hunted animals. They did this instead of eating meat left behind by predators. Predators hunt **prey**. Prey are animals used for food.

They made hunting tools. They sharpened stones for cutting. They made wooden spears. They made stone tips. They made bows and arrows. They made bone fishhooks.
