Blunt means having a dull edge.

Bountiful means that there is more than enough of something.

*scarce, plentiful, ample, abundant*

Name things that are bountiful in your home and explain why.



Demolish means to tear down or destroy something.

*build, assemble, erect, wreck*

Name structures that get demolished and explain why.



Generous means freely giving.
