3. Instead of taking Zac's van, what else might Tim have done to get to the bash?



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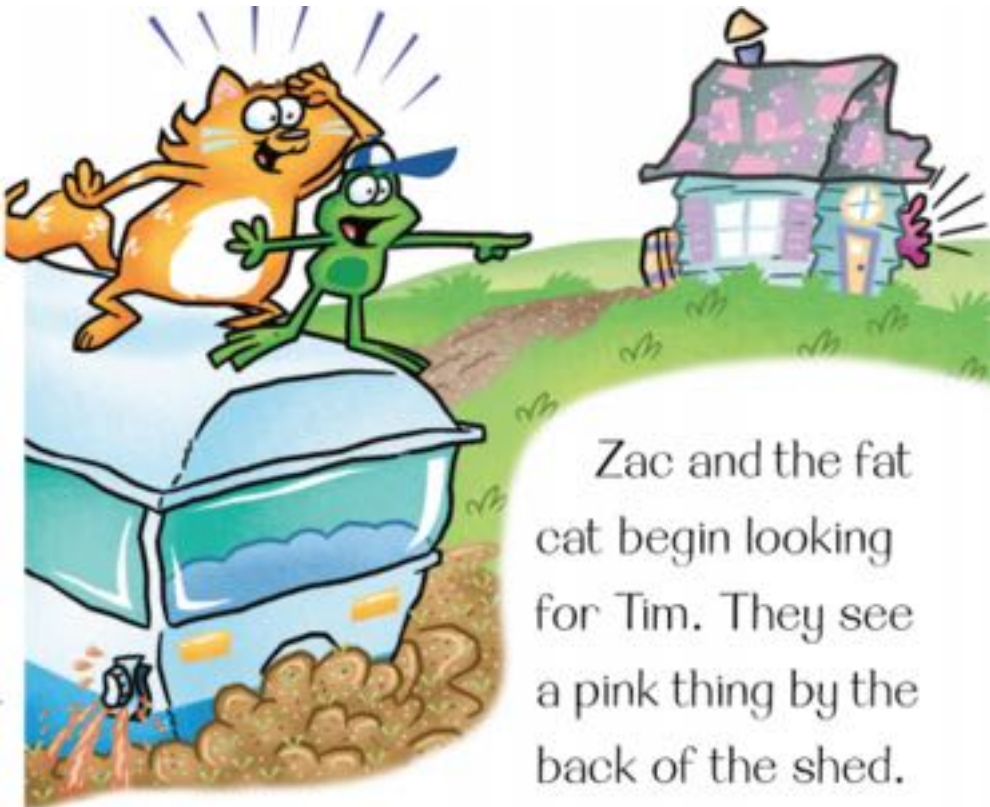
