

## Activity 6: Identifying End Sounds in Words

### Let's find the end sound in a word

Here is a picture of a sock. What is the last sound in "sock"? Tell the child the answer if needed (ck). Now try these.



Here is a picture of a kite. What is the last sound in **kite**? (t)

Here is a picture of a tin. What is the last sound in **tin**? (n)

Here is a picture of a fish. What is the last sound in **fish**? (sh)

The word is dress. What is the last sound in **dress**? (s)

The word is leg. What is the last sound in **leg**? (g)

The word is bird. What is the last sound in **bird**? (d)

The word is school. What is the last sound in **school**? (l)

The word is puff. What is the last sound in **puff**? (f)

The word is gum. What is the last sound in **gum**? (m)
